- 2. The Admissions Committee will review the documents.
- 3. A family interview will then be scheduled.
- 4. We will then schedule an appointment for your child to shadow at CCA and to take the Independent School Entrance Exam.
- 5. CCA will inform families within two weeks of the interview as to the decision of acceptance.
- 6. Upon acceptance, a \$200 enrollment fee is required to hold your child's place at CCA. *This fee* is non-refundable and is due within fourteen days of acceptance.

We look forward to walking through this application process with you. CCA strives to be your partner in the education of your child while helping to prepare he or she for life outside the walls of school.
